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	BBMR noted that Sodexo, Guam Power Authority (GPA), and Guam Waterworks Authority remain as the big payables.	
	BBMR asked if the \$120,758 balance from Payless Markets, Inc. was for student meals. GDOE confirmed the amount was for food commodities and cafeteria. At one point, GDOE had a contract with Payless to use their chillers to store some of the food.	
	BBMR asked if the Benson Guam Enterprises payable was for capital improvement projects. GDOE replied that it was for supplies, and facilities and maintenance.	
	BBMR asked what Phoenix Pacific (Guam) was for. GDOE replied fire alarms.	
IV. Financial Status Designation Report		
a. January 2022	BBMR reported that for:  Overall: C-Watch was placed for Benefits, Power, Water, and Telephone.  Monthly Variance: B-Warning was placed for Benefits, Miscellaneous, Water, and Telephone.  Year-to-Date Variance: B-Warning was placed for Salary, Benefits, Miscellaneous, Power, Water, and Telephone.	
	BBMR asked if GDOE use GEFF to pay most of its utility bills, which was causing the C-Watches. BBMR hoped that the projected lapses/shortfall would decrease with the release of allotments.	
	BBMR asked DOA about the GEFF collections. DOA replied that its Director agreed to release some revenues to GDOE. GDOE notified DOA that it needed to pay GPA	

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	by next week. DOA will work with GDOE on the amount to be released, as it has yet to recover the \$10 million (M) from the school leaseback.	
	GDOE explained to the EFSC that it paid \$300,000 of the \$2.2M it had in arrears. GPA was trying to recover the remaining \$1.9M to not float the 90+ days. GDOE gave assurance that a supplemental payment will be made. GDOE thanked DOA for its assistance. GDOE needs the information of when and how much of GEFF will be provided to prevent interruption of service.	
	BBMR asked if GDOE has an agreement with GPA. GDOE did not know if an agreement was made in the past. GDOE was asked by GPA to draft a payment plan, but needs the information from DOA to finalize it. GDOE stated in the draft that payments are based on cash availability.
