The award is to implement the Title V-A Consolidated Grant activities as approved to the outlying areas, including Guam, CNMI, U.S. Virgin Islands, and American Samoa. To ensure compliance, GDOE is hosting a FY'16 Grant Award Notification, Implementation, Reporting and Accountability Workshop training for all grant/program managers, project directors, and program staff. The workshop encompasses Civil Rights training including Title IX and Title II, as well as Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) overviews in addressing GDOE's High Risk designation and in preparation for US-Ed's visit next month.

The Title V-A CG funds varies project activities such as the After School Programs for Instruction, Remediation, and Enrichment (ASPIRE), Eskuelan Puengi (night school), Career Technical Education (CTE) for high school courses, School Resource Officers, and Gifted and Talented Education.
