Tamuning Elementary School Back to Traditional School Schedule

Tiyan, Guam – The Guam Department of Education (GDOE), **Tamuning Elementary School is please to announce that the school will resume the Traditional School Schedule starting today, January 31, 2024. This means that students from Second to Fifth grade will be in school for the full week, from Monday to Friday.**

- **Bus riders: Bus will pick-up at their designated time and area.**
- **Car riders: Drop off at 7:15am, at the front of Buildings A and C.**
- **Walkers: The gate will be open by 7:15am.**

Tamuning Elementary School had implemented an Alternating Schedule in which two student populations had to alternate their presence on campus every other day. Students were divided into two Cohorts that alternated between attending school in-person or online. The alternating schedule has been in effect since the start of the school year.
