The school received a Feb. 7 eviction notice from property owner Nan Chul Shin Trust. The owner, through attorney Daniel Berman, said Guahan Academy failed to pay the first and second installment of \$245,000, under an amended May 2017 agreement to buy the land for the new Tiyan campus.

Since then, representatives from the school have been trying to work out an agreement to postpone the eviction.

Originally, the eviction was supposed to take place Feb. 14.
